1 Your bin is collected



2 by the council waste truck

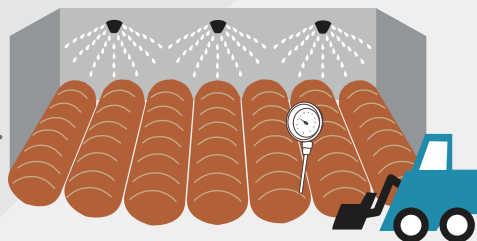
3 the contents are taken to the SMRC



4 where they are dropped off

5 the large and dangerous items are sorted

6 waste is loaded into giant composters which turn for 3 days



7 compost is screened for inorganic material

8 compost is then kept in rows in a giant shed and watered for 4-6 weeks

9 compost is screened again

10 inorganic material is removed



11 compost is taken and further processed to be used on farms, parks and gardens
